

STAGE 1 DROUGHT WATCH FOR LAKE BELTON

Due to drought conditions within the Brazos River Basin, including our own water source, Lake Belton, The Brazos River Authority is implementing a Stage 1 Drought Watch Condition.

A Stage 1 Watch Condition means that is now necessary for this system, Elm Creek Water Supply Corporation, to request that our customers *voluntarily* conserve water whenever possible, and minimize, or discontinue water use for all non-essential purposes.

As part of these **Voluntary Water Restrictions** we are asking that you adhere to the following schedule when irrigating landscapes:

Addresses ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8

Midnight to 10:00 am
&
8:00 pm to Midnight

Addresses ending in 1,3,5,7, or 9

Midnight to 10:00 am
&
8:00 pm to Midnight

The water supply and drought conditions are being monitored within the basin. You will be notified in the same manner as this notice, whenever changes under the Plan are made, or when additional action is required.
